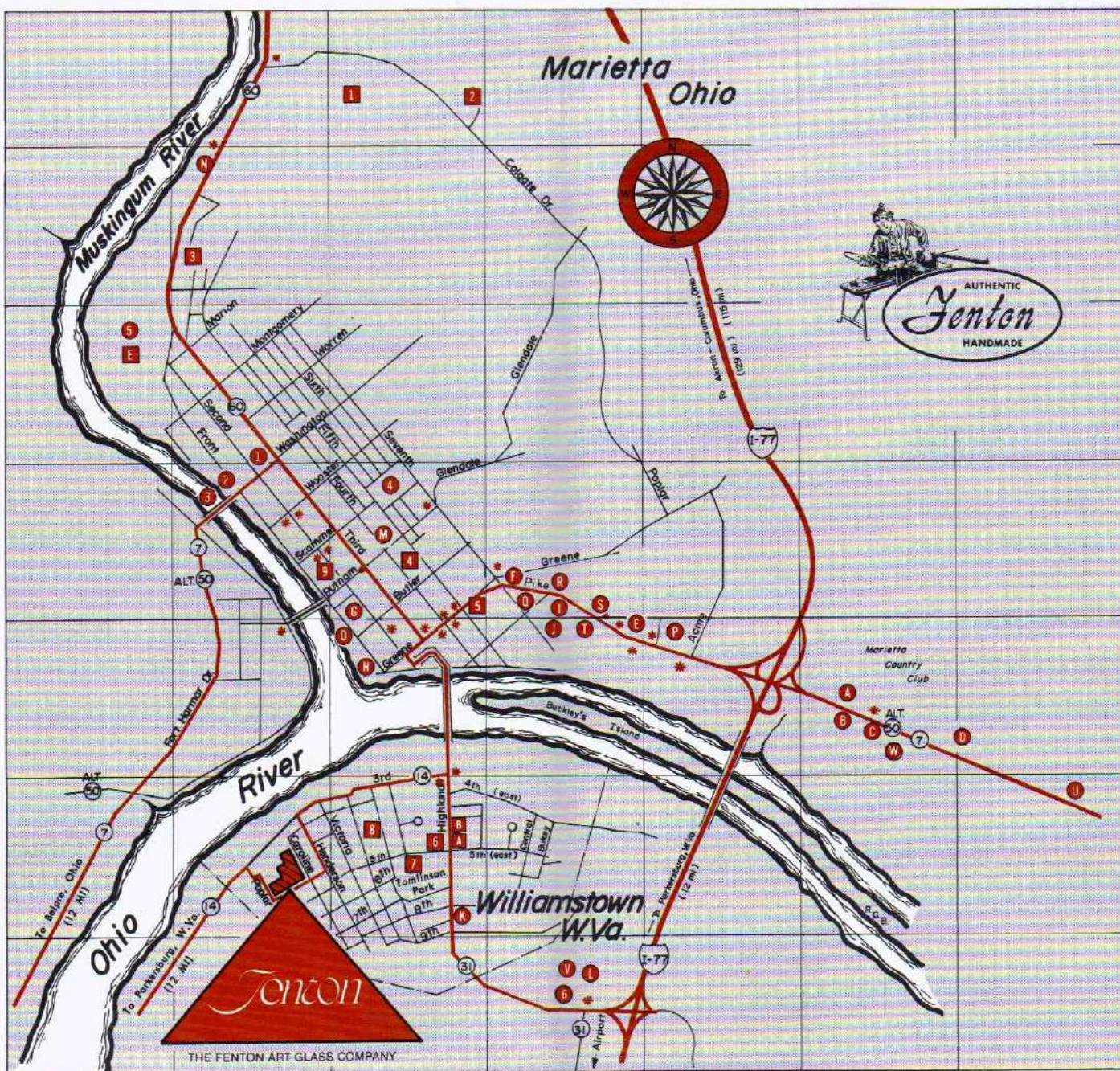
NEW DISPLAYS AT THE FENTON GLASS MUSEUM

More examples of Ohio Valley Glass have been added. The major emphasis is on Fenton Glass made during the first 50 years (1905-1955).

Representative glass of other Ohio Valley companies (Aetna, Beatty, Beaumont, Northwood, LaBelle, Fostoria, Imperial, New Martinsville, Paden City, Riverside, Jefferson, Hobbs, and others) is displayed with items of historical interest.

A 30 minute movie on the making of Fenton Glass is shown at regular times throughout the day.

There is an admission charge to see the Museum and the movie.
