



Designed by Delmar Stowasser and handmade by the most skilled Fenton glassblowers, each piece is artfully "cased" with three different layers of glass.

After the interior color has been overlaid with a second opaque color, the artist deftly applies glass threads in a way that will best complement the final shape of each piece. The threads are fused into the opaque glass and a third glass, crystal, is then gathered over the entire creation.

The piece is then blown to its final shape with each pattern varying slightly as the threads fuse and stretch with the glass. Each is a unique piece of handcrafted art glass.





Geometrics

Inspired by the re-emergence of the Art Deco influence in home decorating, Richard Delaney has used the clean, geometric lines of the period to create a sophisticated, contemporary look for Fenton.

Beginning with sleek, polished glass, Delaney has etched each piece to best complement its form and function. Done in three colors, Gray, Rose and Periwinkle, the collection makes a strong fashion statement for 1985.












Finishing—Fenton glass is truly "Handmade in America." As we see here, each piece is formed and finished by a craftsman proud of his art.



Each glass "dot" in the Masterworks Collection begins with a bit gathered at the end of a punty and heated until smooth. The craftsman will touch the end of the glass bit to the vase and quickly cut it with the shears you see here.
