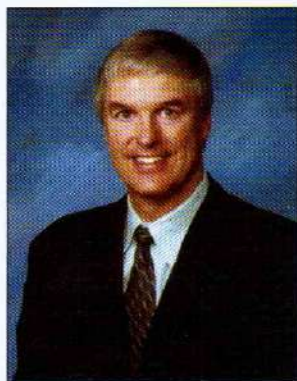


We're celebrating 100 years!

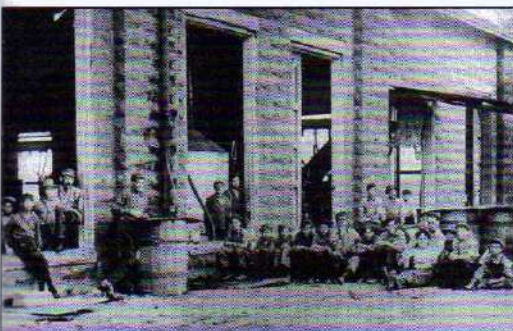

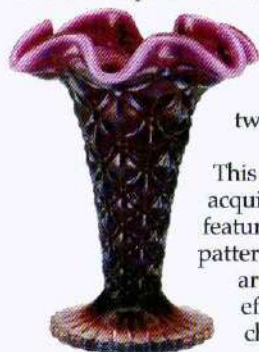


Fenton Rep Open House Event 2005 Exclusive

This vase, made from a mould acquired recently from Indiana Glass, features an interesting geometric pattern and a six-point crimp. Fenton artisans create the opalescent effect by allowing the glass to chill briefly and then reheating it.

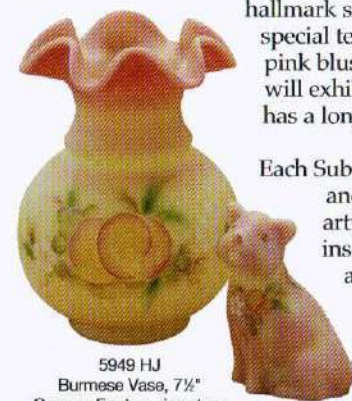

Glass Messenger 2005 Subscriber Exclusives

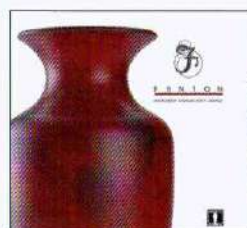
