# The Complete Fenton Experience

If you wish to visit the Museum, see the movie, and take a tour, please proceed to the Museum through the back door of the Gift Shop at the rear of the seconds area. Check the schedules on the inside of this brochure to be sure you have enough time to take a tour after the movie. If you wish to take a tour, request a green tour card from the Museum attendant. Tours will be announced in the Museum and in the Gift Shop. After your tour, you may return to the Museum or the Gift Shop for as long as you wish.

## Shop and Tour Only

If you plan only to shop and take the tour, please take a numbered card. Your number will be called on the public address system at the start of each tour, and will begin at the rear door of the Gift Shop.

## Movie and/or Museum Only

Please proceed directly to the Museum through the rear door of the Gift Shop.

To help you plan your visit to Fenton Art Glass, we are listing the normal June, July and August tour and movie schedules. These are subject to change during very busy days or because of changes in the factory work schedule.

The Gift Shop and Museum are not open on Sunday or on the six major national Holidays.

The Museum, movie theater and Gift Shop will be open on Saturday from 8:00 to 5:00 P.M.
