The Connoisseur Collection

The Connoisseur Collection demonstrates Fenton's commitment to a vanishing art form. Artistic treatments developed during the 19th century "Age of Glass" have been recreated by the proud crafts men and women at Fenton. Careful research into the styles and methods of Bohemian, English and American art glass inspired each creation. Signed by the artist and numbered, each piece is packaged in a Limited Edition box with its own certificate.

"Empire"

It takes twenty-six people to produce this cranberry pitcher which is then sent to a skilled decorator. Designed by Martha Reynolds, "Empire" reflects the character of a Moser enameled decoration done in the mid-1800's in Bohemia.

Marbleized Box

The Wave Crest box has been designed by Frances Burton to capture the look of the Kelva marked Waved Crest ware produced by C. F. Monroe around 1904. Opal glass is covered with a marbleized lustre and fired. An enameled floral "Poppy and Daisy" is then applied and refired. The finishing touch is a delicate antique brass band.

The vase is made of custard glass which was first developed in the U.S. about 1890. The vase is blown, reheated, iridized with two metallic salt formulas and heated again to develop a gold lustre. The surface is then sandcarved away to reveal three glimmering fish floating in a hand-painted coral sea.

Designed by Martha Reynolds to recreate the charm of an American glass antique. The Rosalene striping will vary from one piece to another as each is warmed in by hand and slowly reheated to develop the intense pink color.

How is Crackle Glass Made?

The Crackle Glass treatment is achieved in the hand-blown process. It begins with molten glass being gathered on the end of a hollow blow pipe. It is then placed into cool water which fractures the outer surface of the glass and then reheated to seal the cracks. This procedure may be repeated as many as 3 times on the larger pieces. The glass is then blown into the final forming mould and an iridescent finish is applied.
