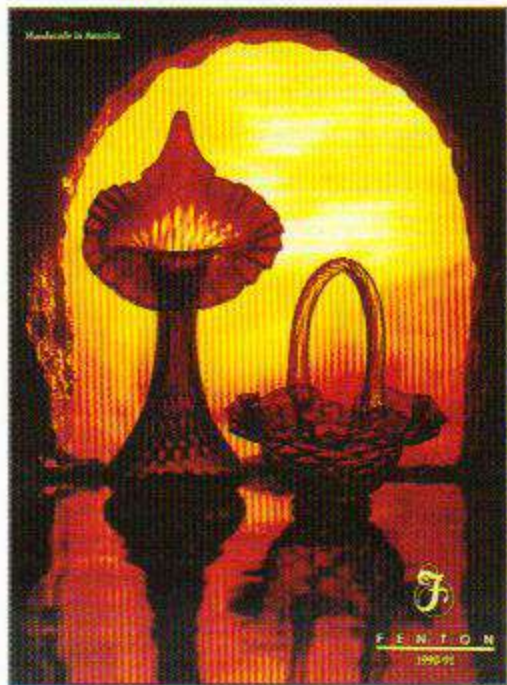

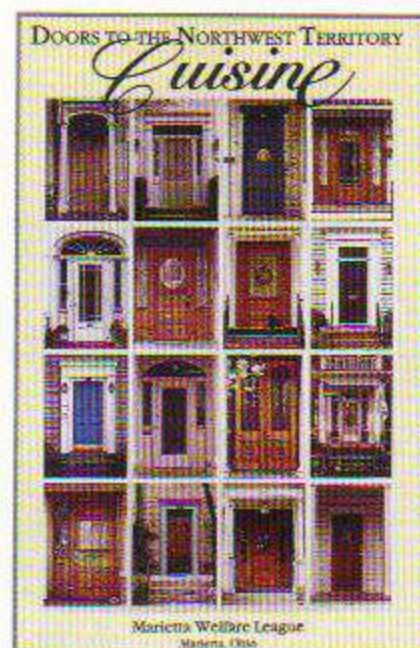
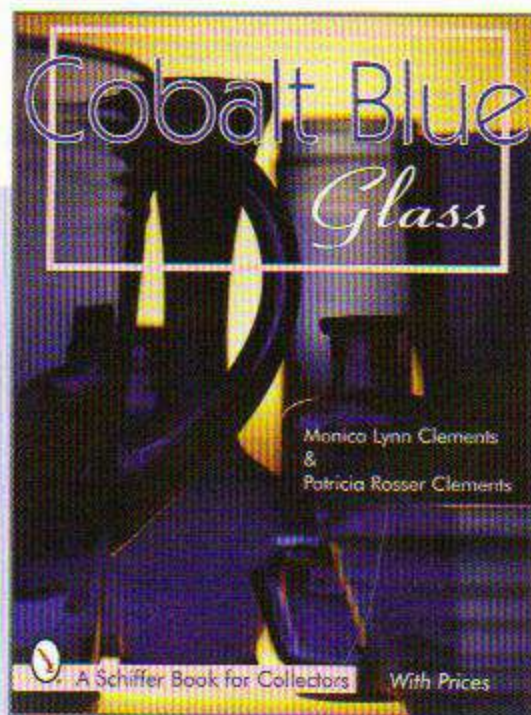


**Hearts of Glass

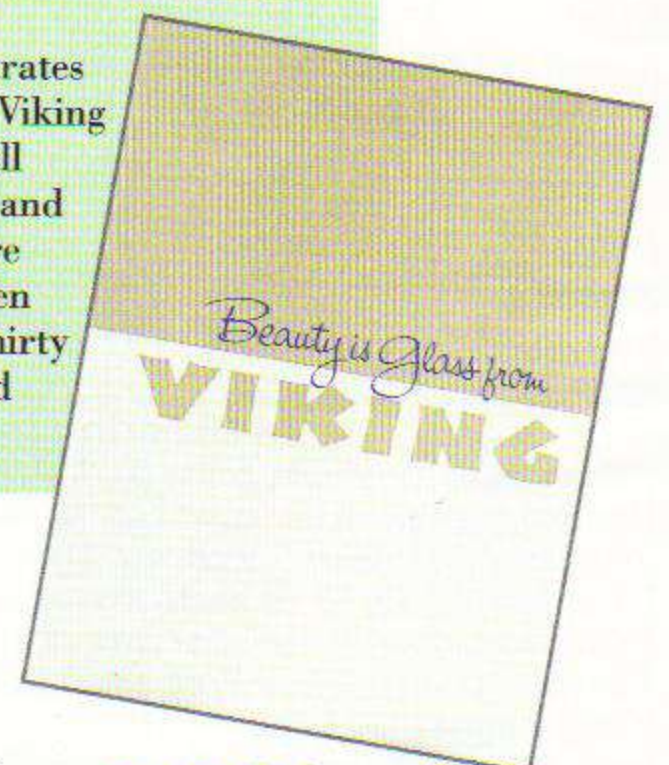
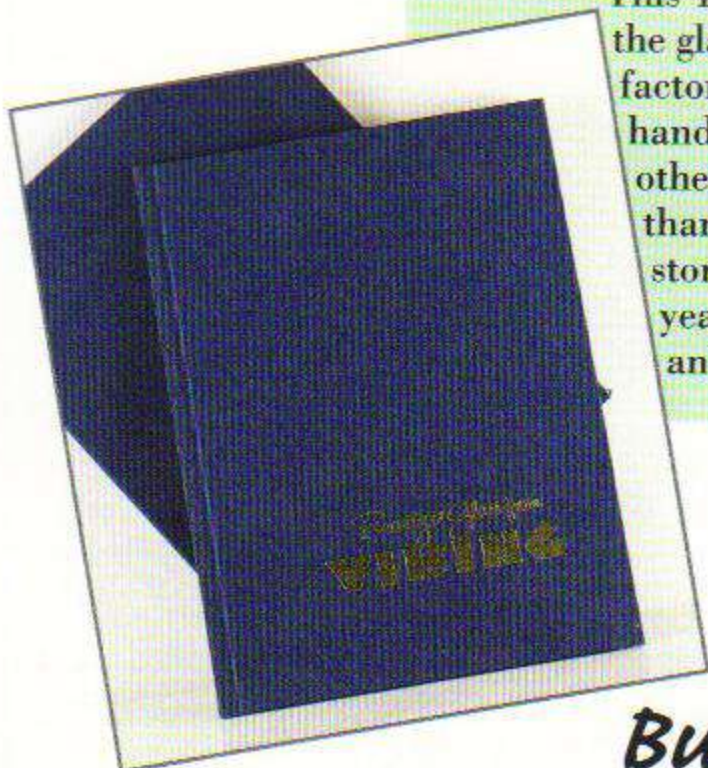
**Doors to the Northwest

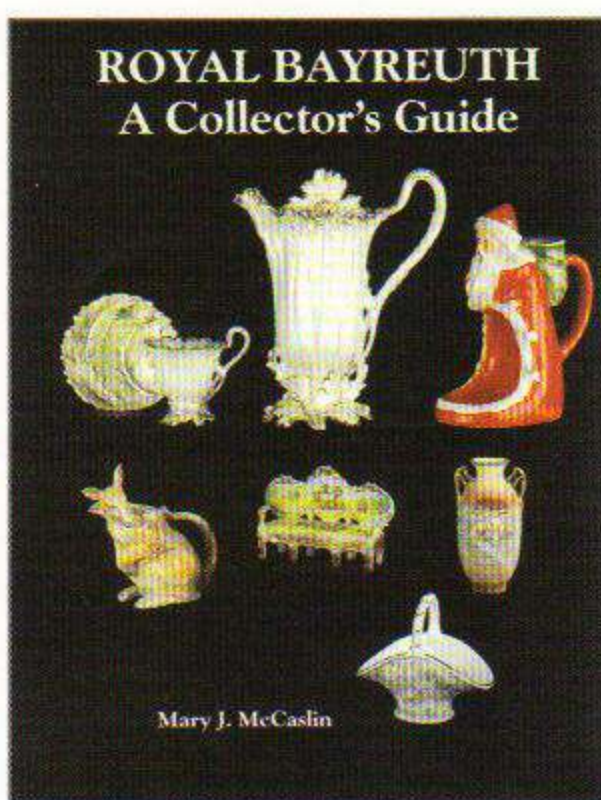

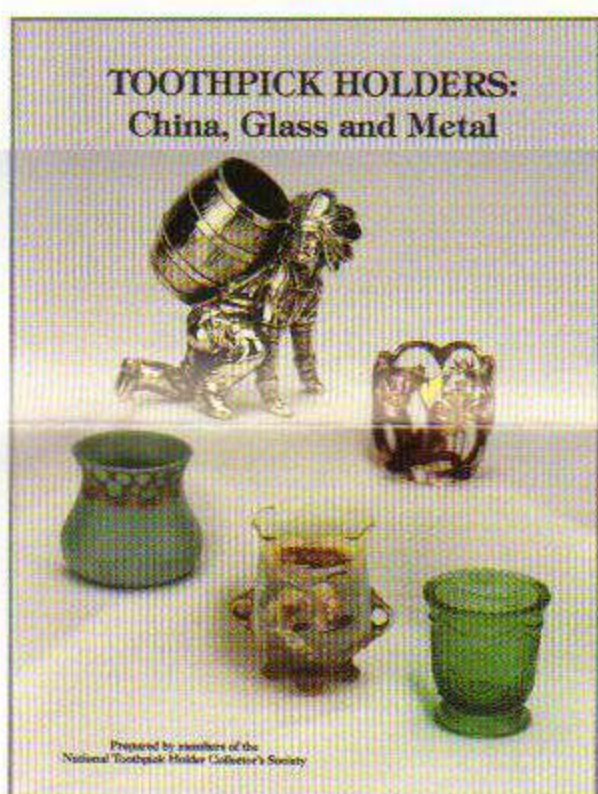
Royal Bayreuth: A Collector's Guide

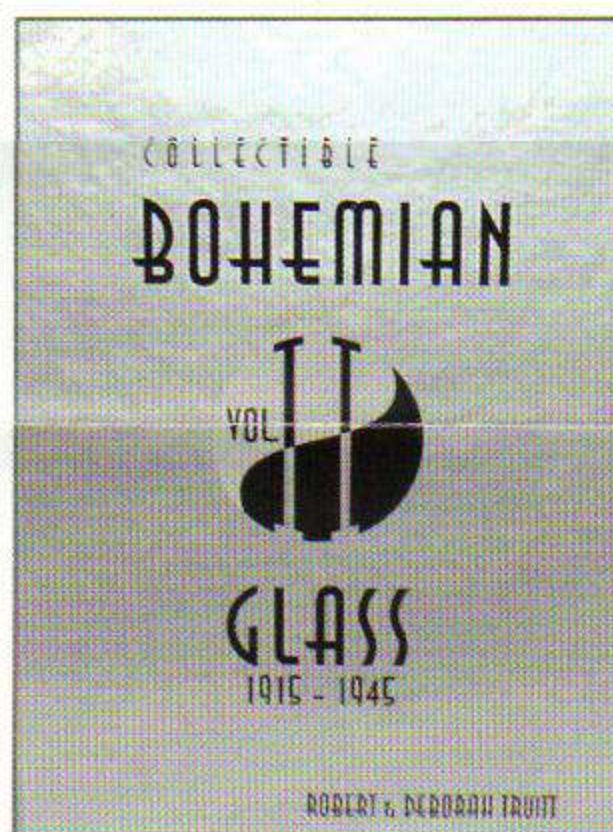


Toothpick Holders: China, Glass, and Metal

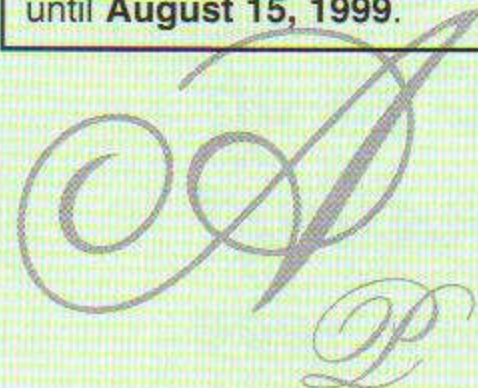
